

ADVANCE INQUIRY ON DANGEROUS GOODS

When transporting extremely dangerous goods or shipments weighing more than 100,000 kg, in addition to an advance notification, an advance inquiry must be submitted three days before the arrival to the Port of Turku. The purpose of the advance inquiry is to ensure that the shipment can be transported via the Port of Turku as direct export/import.

Even after an approved advance inquiry the arrival of the cargo in question must be reported in accordance with normal practice 24 hours in advance.
